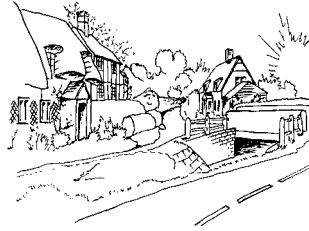


ARKESDEN PARISH COUNCIL

4. Matters Arising

4.1 Prospective Parish Councillors

It was agreed to advertise the elections more thoroughly via the website and the Village News. The Parish Council would continue to ask prospective candidates along to observe PC meetings. The Clerk will attend an “election meeting” on 28th Feb. when election packs will be available.

4.2 Litter and Fly Tipping

The debris at the bottom of Long Lane had been cleared by UDC. The Parish Council agreed to have the village litter pick as early as possible – 2nd week in March? – before the vegetation starts to grow.

A broken sign had been reported dumped at the end of The Old Coach Road off the Wicken Road, but there is no missing sign in the village? Clerk would report the dumped sign.

5.1.1 Pebblings Field
