We have lost regular hire income with the disbanding of the Women's Institute, but this was compensated by income from the London to Cambridge Cycle Ride - many thanks to those who helped out. This will hopefully make a regular visit to the village so we therefore expect a similar income pattern for the upcoming year.

Expenditure

Expenditure this year has been in line with previous years, being largely dominated by insurance, utility and cleaning payments. We continue with our maintenance programme, replacing the fridge and decorating the exterior of the Hall. We have some outstanding maintenance tasks (fixing/replacing of heaters and repairing the fire-exit door jamb), which we hope to complete this year, which will impact our reserves.
