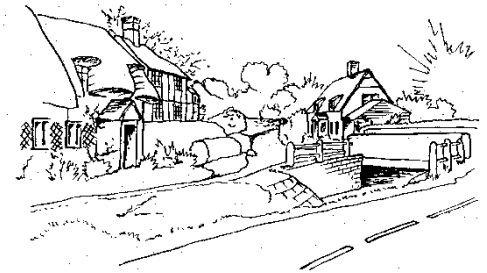

- New Applications
- **UTT/26/0702/FUL** - Part retrospective and part full planning application to convert an agricultural barn into three residential dwellings - Building To The Rear Of Mulberry House, Wenden Road – Comments due 22 July

Following conversations by email, Councillors agreed to object to the application due to concerns regarding the current proposal being materially more substantial than the original development that was approved under Class Q and how it effectively achieves, through incremental alterations, a scale of development that extends beyond what was previously accepted. Comments also included concerns about sustainability, road safety, proximity to a listed building and protected lanes.

Work remains outstanding for joining the new railings to the existing ones as the workers were unable to establish how to do this without removing the oak posts, which was discouraged. The workers confirmed that they would be feeding back to the central team to establish next steps.
